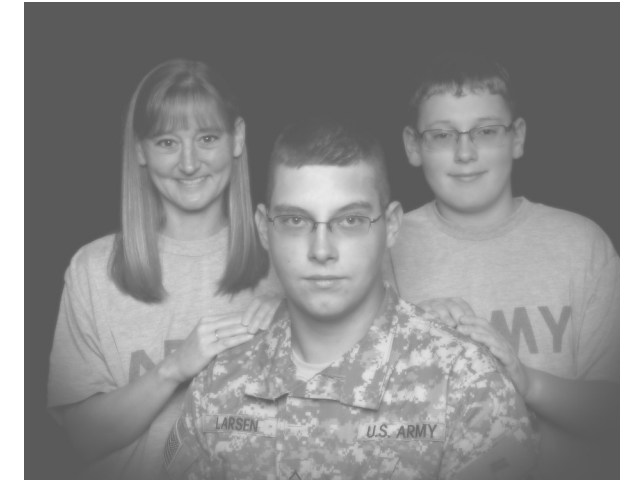

Kelli, from Sycamore, wanted very much to stay in the area. She had been on our wait list for almost three years. The day she got the call that we had closed on property she said was one of the most exciting days of her life—it meant the opportunity for her to own her own home, finally. Her son, Eathon, is a member of the U. S. Army and is currently stationed in South Korea. She sent him a message telling him their dream had come true. She waited to tell her son Keagon that there was a possibility until they knew for sure and he was extremely excited to hear the news as well.

Eathon was home on a two week visit recently and did get to spend some time at the house. Kelli, so far, has enjoyed taking part in the rehab because she gets to see it unfold from old to new in front of her eyes. Words cannot describe for her what it will be like to be in her own....home.

BOARD UPDATE

As with many non-profit organizations, we operate with a Board of Directors (the Board). The Board is responsible for the functioning of our affiliate including deciding if families qualify to partner with us, where we build, and how we build among many other things. We have a part-time Administrative Assistant that keeps the daily workings of the affiliate running whom reports to the Board.

We are currently seeking board members. Some of the responsibility of the Board is to act on building decisions, seek out and approve the purchase of land or homes to rehab, assist during the building process as supervisor on the job site, help with fundraising activities, and assist in making any other crucial decisions that may arise or be presented to the board.

Habitat for Humanity of DeKalb County functions as a 'mortgage' holder to our partner families through a no interest mortgage. There is a process that a family must go through in order to see if they qualify. Once they qualify they assist in the building/rehabbing of their home by being on-site during the build process. The Board functions as mentors through that process and guides them in the steps they need to complete once they partner with us. After their home is built we function as support as needed and offer advice as questions arise. We are not a 'landlord' to the families but a support system.

If you are interested in getting involved but don't think you can because you have no building qualifications—please don't let that scare you away. Many of our board members, past and present, had no building experience when they came on the board. They wanted to be involved with an organization that was making the difference in their community. Please attend one of our next meetings. Meetings are held on the first Thursday of the month at 6:30pm in the conference room next to our office.
